- Aimed at promoting intergenerational integration, a joint collaboration between students from Greenwood Primary School, Rainbow Centre Singapore and SNM residents will also showcase 90 art pieces, out of which, 10 of the best art pieces will be presented at the silent auction. Intergenerational integration plays an important role in developing an inclusive Singapore; it addresses the societal needs for social integration to keep ahead of time.
- 3 600 pieces of door gifts were also produced by the beneficiaries of the "Smile With You" programme, which is a collaborative project between Sree Narayana Mission and Project Smile.
- In a collaborative effort, the dinner will witness a performance by MINDS (Movement for the Intellectually Disabled) and Heart Enterprise, which is a Social Enterprise to engage Persons with Special Needs.

About Sree Narayana Mission (Singapore)

In keeping with Sree Narayana Guru's teachings, SNM provides a wide range of social service programmes for the less-privileged regardless of race or religion.

SNM operates a 224-bed nursing home, Sree Narayana Mission Nursing Home and two Senior Care Centres for the elderly. One Senior Care Centre is co-located with the Nursing Home in Yishun and offers a Maintenance Day Care Programme.

The other Senior Care Centre is located at Woodlands and offers both Maintenance Day Care and Dementia Day Care Programmes. SNM also manages Meranti Home, a 200-bed psychiatric welfare home for male destitutes.

SNM also runs community programmes to cater to the needs of the less-privileged including programmes for single mothers, educational financial assistance and befriender services.

SNM is an Institution of Public Character (since 1984).

SNM was one of 47 Charities who received the Charity Transparency Awards 2018, awarded by the Charity Council. The award recognises charities with good disclosure practices that the Charity Transparency Framework (CTF) recommends.
