

瑞那拉耶拿教会与两机构合作 拟勿洛设乐龄看护中心 推出应用捕捉摔倒数据

慈善机构瑞那拉耶拿教会与新加坡马拉雅里协会计划在勿洛设立新的乐龄看护中心，应付年长者需求。教会也将与科技公司推出可以实时捕捉年长者摔倒相关数据的应用。

瑞那拉耶拿教会（Sree Narayana Mission）星期天（9月11日）在一场庆祝活动上与两家合作伙伴签署上述谅解备忘录。

根据协议，瑞那拉耶拿教会和新加坡马拉雅里协会（Singapore Malayalee Association）将在勿洛蓄水池路第141座组屋设立乐龄看护中心，以在满足目前的需求之余，也能应付社区里年长者人数增加的趋势。

成立于1948年的瑞那拉耶拿教会，目前设有一家养老院、两个乐龄看护中心以及柏兰夷村 Meranti Home收容所。教会第二间位于义顺的养老院预计于2025年

Sree Narayana Mission signed a Memorandum of Understanding with two partners at a birth anniversary celebration on Sunday (September 11).

Sree Narayana Mission and the Singapore Malayalee Association will set up a senior care centre at Block 141 Bedok Reservoir Road to meet the current trend of increasing elderly people. They also partnered with Tata Consultancy Services to leverage on technology to benefit not only the needs of the future, but also the seniors in the community. The two agencies will collect, analyse and record data to detect falls in seniors through sensors installed in seniors' homes.

Founded in 1948, Sree Narayana Mission currently operates a nursing home, two senior care centres and the Meranti Home in Pelangi village. The Mission's second nursing home in Yishun is expected to open in 2025.

Minister of Manpower and Second Minister of the Ministry of Trade and Industry Dr. Tan See Leng attended the celebration held at Naval Base Secondary School and witnessed the signing ceremony. For past two years, the celebrations have been suspended due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

In his speech, Dr. Tan See Leng praised the efforts of the Mission, which worked towards improving the living conditions of disadvantaged groups for decades and encouraged the Mission to continue developing community projects and expand on its influence.

He also said that the Sree Narayana Mission has played an important role in the fight against the coronavirus, encouraging seniors to be vaccinated and quickly implementing measures to prevent the spread of the virus, ensuring the safety of seniors under its care.
